Who We Are

Women's Resource Center is driven by compassion for women and families facing difficult pregnancy situations. What began as a small hotline in 1990 has grown into a comprehensive support network, empowering clients, and preserving life. The Center expanded, opening offices to offer essential services. The Covington Center was closed in 2022, and the Mobile Medical Unit was launched to reach rural communities. Our service models aim to effectively support women at risk of abortion and provide life-saving measures for the unborn.

What We Do

The Center provides high quality medical care, at no cost to its clients, to educate and support women and their families experiencing unplanned pregnancies. WRC also equips the communities around them to make a life-changing impact. All services are free of charge.

WRC does not offer or refer patients for pregnancy terminations.

A Process Provided by YOU

Our optimized step-by-step process doesn't happen without you. It's because of you, we are able to provide services which have the greatest impact for life decisions.













Our volunteers and staff receive each woman with open arms in her moment of need. You provide compassion, hope, help, and truth to each woman we serve.

Pregnancy testing is one of our most sought-after services. Our pregnancy tests are of the highest quality, rated at 99.9% accuracy in laboratory settings. Our goal is to provide compassionate support and assistance every step of the way to help clients choose life.

Studies show that 85% of women considering abortion will choose life for their unborn child after seeing an ultrasound. This remarkable statistic highlights how this medical tool can truly be a lifesaving resource.

Our services save lives. Not all women considering abortion share their final decision with us, but we know AT LEAST these babies were saved after their mothers came to us seeking help. We were able to minister to them and provide free services.

STI testing and treatments allow us to discuss abstinence and the concept of sexuality as designed by God. The STI services were initiated in 2022.

Did you know that 80% of children's car seats are installed incorrectly? That's a startling statistic, but the good news is WRC is a certified car seat fit station for the state of Indiana. Our certified technicians ensure car seats are properly installed and adjusted for maximum safety.

Christ's Ministry

I recently counseled a woman who was undecided about what she wanted to do with her baby but was seriously considering abortion. The patient was considering her options for several reasons. Being uncertain of the paternity of the child was the primary reason. In addition, she had previously had a high-risk pregnancy, plus her financial situation was uncertain. All three of these issues are common reasons a woman may consider abortion.

Fortunately, the ultrasound saw a tiny 5-millimeter baby with a great heart rate that was easy to hear. That little booming sound—the sound of life—spoke louder than any words I could say.

As I spoke with the patient about the services and programs available to her, she told me she wanted to keep her baby and was grateful to have a place like WRC available to help and support her. I offered her a second ultrasound in a couple of weeks so I would have another opportunity to talk and support her.

I have a great deal of gratitude for this clinic, which is God's ministry. It means so much to me that Women's Resource Center offer free, high-quality medical services to our clients. We care about women and how we can best serve them. Christ's love and your partnership are shown in everything we do.

SAVING BABIES IN A POST-ROE ERA

Mary, who lives in a large city far away, called our Center wanting an ultrasound appointment that same day. She was considering her options, with abortion being her first choice, but said she would keep the baby if she was further than six weeks along. Her reasons for abortion: she and the baby's father were not together, he had other children, and would not support them. Also, Mary wasn't sure she had the financial means to support this new baby. **During her ultrasound appointment, I saw a beautiful nine-week old baby! Praise the Lord! Mary declared she was going to parent her child.**

Indiana has a ban on abortion. The closest abortion clinics are in Illinois, at least two hours away. Women seeking abortion are first reaching out to centers like WRC that are closer to home and provide free medical services. Since the ban, I have seen more women than ever before who are seriously considering abortion. I thank God for every opportunity He provides for us to care and minister to these women.

Diaper Giveaway

In 2023, we were able to host an amazing four diaper giveaways - two in Fountain County and two in Crawfordsville. We are in awe of the generosity and support from our community partners, Legacy Church, and East Side Baptist. Both churches stepped up to provide diapers and minister the Gospel of Christ to those who attended the giveaways.

Additionally, we organized five Cute Threads events, offering free secondhand clothing to the communities. All five of the events were well received.







The Encouraging Moms' Club has gained momentum since its inception in 2023. providing vital support and resources to women. The program has seen remarkable growth, with six active groups across three locations. The club offers monthly group meetings with meals, devotionals, and fellowship. The mentorship program is the heart of the club. Clients are paired with dedicated mentors to address a range of topics. Some have transitioned from abusive situations into healthier relationships with the support of their mentors. The support group's devotional topics cover parenting, relationships, and Christ's love. Volunteers are needed to facilitate classes, watch children, prepare meals, and serve as mentors.
